

CABOT SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETING

WARNING

The legal voters of the Town School District of Cabot are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Cabot School Gymnasium, Cabot, Vermont on March 6, A.D. 2007 at one o'clock in the afternoon to transact the following business:

Article 1. To elect a Moderator.

Article 2. To elect two school directors by Australian ballot:
One for 2 years
One for 3 years

Article 3. Shall the voters of the Town School District approve the minutes of the March 7, 2006 Annual School District Meeting?

Article 4. To hear a report by the School Directors.

Article 5. Shall the voters of the Town School District approve the sum of \$3,342,561 necessary for the support of its school for the year beginning July 1, 2007?

Article 6. Shall the voters of the Town School District appropriate the audited fund balance as of June 30, 2007 for deposit in the Reserve Fund?

Article 7. Legal voters request the Cabot School Board to call and warn a special meeting to reconsider the following article as last voted on December 21, 2006.

Shall general obligation bonds or notes of Cabot Town School District in an amount not to exceed One million six hundred ten thousand seven hundred twelve Dollars (\$1,610,712), subject to reduction from available state and/or federal construction grants-in-aid and appropriations (estimated to be \$483,214), be issued for the purpose of financing the District's share of the cost of making certain public improvements, viz: gymnasium renovations and additions, the estimated cost of such improvements being One million six hundred ten thousand seven hundred twelve Dollars (\$1,610,712), the District's bonded indebtedness for such purpose estimated One million one hundred twenty seven thousand four hundred ninety eight Dollars (\$1,127,498)?

The Board of School Directors of Cabot Town School District proposes to incur bonded and other indebtedness for the purpose of planning, permitting and making school building improvements at an estimated cost of \$1,610,712. It is estimated that 100 percent of the project will not be eligible for state school construction aid. It is anticipated that state and/or federal school construction aid and appropriations aggregating approximately \$483,214 will be available for the project. State funds may not be available at the time this project is otherwise eligible to receive state school construction aid. The District is responsible for all costs incurred in connection with any borrowing done in anticipation of

anticipation of the receipt of school construction aid. (To be voted on by Australian Ballot)

Article 8. Legal voters request the rescission of Article 3 voted at the special town meeting election on December 21, 2006.

Shall general obligation bonds or notes of Cabot Town School District in an amount not to exceed One million twenty three thousand one hundred eighty Dollars (\$1,023,180), subject to reduction from available state and/or federal construction grants-in-aid and appropriations (estimated to be \$787,760), be issued for the purpose of financing the District's share of the cost of making certain public improvements, viz: the addition of a wood chip heating system, the estimated cost of such improvements being One million twenty three thousand one hundred eighty Dollars (\$1,023,180), the District's bonded indebtedness for such purpose estimated Two hundred thirty five thousand four hundred twenty Dollars (\$235,420)? (To be voted on by Australian Ballot)

Article 9. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.

Article 10. To adjourn this meeting.
