**TOWN OF CABOT**

The Legal Voters of the Town of Cabot are hereby warned and notified to meet at the Cabot School Gymnasium, Cabot, Vermont, on MARCH 6<sup>th</sup> A. D., 2007 at ten o'clock in the forenoon [10:00 a.m.] to transact the following business: [The polls will be open from 10:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M.]

- Art. 1. To elect a Moderator for the ensuing year.
- Art. 2. Shall the town vote to approve the minutes of the previous Annual Town Meeting of March 7, 2006?
- Art. 3. To elect a Selectperson for a term of three years.

- Art. 4. Shall the Town of Cabot grant to Faith In Action Partnership the sum of \$5,000 to help defray the starting of a "Senior Adventure Morning" program for Cabot residents from the \$23,029 of UDAG Funds available for Town Meeting Grants in 2007? [Australian ballot]
- Art. 5. Shall the Town of Cabot grant to the Cabot Public Library the sum of \$12,788.50 to help defray the cost of constructing new library shelving from the \$23,029 of UDAG Funds available for Town Meeting Grants in 2007? [Australian ballot]
- Art. 6. Shall the Town of Cabot grant to the Cabot United Church the sum of \$5,240 to partially fund the cost of hooking into the Cabot School wood chip boiler plant from the \$23,029 of UDAG Funds available for Town Meeting Grants in 2007? [Australian ballot]
- Art. 7. Shall the Town vote to hear and act upon the reports of the

several Town Officers?

- Art. 8. Shall the Town vote to pay its Real and Personal Property taxes to the Town Treasurer on or before November 13, 2007, with delinquent taxes having interest charges of one percent per month for the first three months and one and one-half percent per month thereafter and an eight percent penalty charged from the due date?
- Art. 9. To elect all Town Officers required by law, according to law?
- Art. 10. Shall the Town authorize the Selectboard to apply for and receive grants and gifts and to spend any grants and gifts received in the current fiscal year, excluding UDAG funds, block grants and unrestricted gifts?
- Art. 11. Shall the Town authorize the Library Trustees to apply for and receive grants and gifts and to spend any grants and gifts received?
- Art. 12. Shall the Town vote to exempt the so-called Cabot Fire Department and Cabot Ambulance Site from the Education Tax Liability for a period of 10 years, pursuant to 32 V.S.A. Section 3840?
- Art. 13. Shall the Town vote to forgive the remaining principal [\$140,132.78] on the 1994, 30-year UDAG loan to the Cabot Selectboard of \$225,000 at zero percent interest, for the renovations of the Willey Building?
- Art. 14. Shall the Town vote to establish a Sinking Fund for the maintenance of the Willey Building?
- Art. 15. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$7,500 for the Willey Building Sinking Fund?
- Art. 16. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$2,000 to defray the expenses of

restoring the Theatre Curtains in the Willey Building?

Art. 17. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$4,000 to defray the expenses of the Cabot Teen Center?

Art. 18. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$36,500 to defray the expenses of the Cabot Fire Department?

Art. 19. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$13,000 to a Fire Department equipment purchase sinking fund to cover the cost of a new pumper truck in 2 years?

Art. 20. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$350 to purchase flags for Decoration Day?

Art. 21. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$19,500 to help toward the maintenance of the Cabot Cemeteries?

Art. 22. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$7,000 to support the Cabot Ambulance?

Art. 23. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$49,571 to support the Cabot Library?

Art. 24. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$500 to support the Cabot Senior Citizens group?

Art. 25. Shall the Town appropriate the following sums for the following purposes:

- Art. 26. Shall the Town vote to appropriate the sum of \$722,523.88 to repair and maintain the highways of the Town including summer, winter and special treatment, of which an estimated \$211,589.22 is to come from income and an estimated \$510,934.66 from local taxes?
- Art. 27. Shall the Town vote to appropriate the sum of \$371,274.16 to defray the General Expenses of the Town, with an estimated \$58,635.42 to come from income and an estimated \$312,638.74 from local taxes?
- Art. 28. Shall the voters of the Town of Cabot approve a full, complete and detailed accounting of the signed CPA report in the Annual Town Report?
- Art. 29. Shall the voters of the Town of Cabot approve any grant requests by the town, including the specific purpose for which that money is to be applied?

- Art. 30. Shall the voters of the Town of Cabot approve including in the Annual Town Report a full, complete and detailed accounting of all outstanding "old" UDAG loans?
- Art. 31. Shall the voters of the Town of Cabot approve only those registered voters on the voter checklist be allowed entry into the annual town meeting?
- Art. 32. Shall the voters of the Town of Cabot approve changing the polling place for all elections, other than annual town meeting, from the school gym to the Willey Building Town Hall, with those elections held from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.?
- Art. 33. Shall the voters of the Town of Cabot approve abolishing the position of delinquent tax collector and have those taxes collected by the Town Clerk/Treasurer?
- Art. 34. Shall the voters of the Town of Cabot approve reducing the delinquent tax penalty to 4%?
- Art. 35. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
- Art. 36. To adjourn this meeting.
