TOWN OF CABOT

The Legal Voters of the Town of Cabot are hereby warned and notified to meet at the Cabot School Gymnasium, Cabot, Vermont, on MARCH 7th A. D., 2006 at ten o'clock in the forenoon [10:00 a.m.] to transact the following business: [The polls will be open from 10:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M.]

- Art. 1. To elect a Moderator for the ensuing year.
- Art. 2. Shall the town vote to approve the minutes of the previous Annual Town Meeting of March 1, 2005?
- Art. 3. To elect a Selectperson for a term of three years.
[Australian ballot]
- Art. 4. Shall the bonds of the Town of Cabot in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Dollars and no cents [\$300,000.00] be issued for the purpose of financing certain public improvements, Viz: repair and repaving of Town highways? [Australian ballot]
- Art. 5. Shall the Town of Cabot grant to the Cabot Public Library the sum of \$17,924 to help defray the cost of constructing new library shelving from the \$31,424 of UDAG Funds available for Town Meeting Grants in 2006? [Australian ballot]
- Art. 6. Shall the Town of Cabot grant to the War Memorial Committee of the Cabot Historical Society the sum of \$1,500 to help defray the cost of landscaping and updating the Town of Cabot War Memorial from the \$31,424 of UDAG Funds available for Town Meeting Grants in 2006? [Australian ballot]
- Art. 7. Shall the Town of Cabot grant to Faith In Action Partnership the sum of \$5,000 to help defray the start-up costs for expanding their volunteer services for helping elderly and disabled citizens of Cabot from the \$31,424 of UDAG Funds available for Town Meeting Grants in 2006? [Australian ballot]

Art. 8. Shall the Town of Cabot grant to the Cabot Community Association the sum of \$7,000 to support their out of school programs and the teen center (food, supplies, materials and staff stipends for youth and adult staff) from the \$31,424 of UDAG Funds available for Town Meeting Grants in 2006? [Australian ballot]

Art. 9. Shall the Town vote to hear and act upon the reports of the several Town Officers?

Art. 10. Shall the Town pay its Real and Personal Property taxes to the Town Treasurer on or before November 13, 2006, with delinquent taxes having interest charges of one percent per month for the first three months and one and one-half percent per month thereafter and an eight percent penalty charged from the due date?

Art. 11. To elect all Town Officers required by law, according to law.

Art. 12. Shall the Town authorize the Selectboard to apply for and receive grants and gifts and to spend any grants and gifts received in the current fiscal year, excluding UDAG funds, block grants and unrestricted gifts?

Art. 13. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$35,000 to defray the expenses of the Cabot Fire Department?

Art. 14. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$10,000 to a Fire Department equipment purchase sinking fund to cover the cost of a new pumper truck in 3 years?

Art. 15. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$350 to purchase flags for Decoration Day?

Art. 16. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$19,500 to help toward the maintenance of the Cabot Cemeteries?

Art. 17. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$7,000 to support the Cabot Ambulance?

Art. 18. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$38,348 to support the Cabot Library?

Art. 19. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$500 to support the Cabot Senior Citizens group?

Art. 20. Shall the Town appropriate the following sums for the following purposes:

Art. 21. Shall the Town vote the sum of \$50,000 to purchase Ten acres of unimproved land, being the same, more or less, located on Vermont Route 215 South, for the purpose of procuring a site to locate a Town Highway Garage?

Art. 22. Shall the Town vote to appropriate the sum of \$510,328.10 to repair and maintain the highways of the Town including

summer, winter and special treatment, of which an estimated \$147,000.00 is to come from income and an estimated \$363,328.10 from local taxes?

Art. 23. Shall the Town vote to appropriate the sum of \$398,267.16 to defray the General Expenses of the Town, with an estimated \$47,081.81 to come from income and an estimated \$351,185.35 from local taxes?




Art. 24. Shall the voters of the Town of Cabot instruct our State Representatives and Senators to oppose:
-any use of the State Education fund for purposes that are outside the law's original intent to "make payments to school districts and supervisory unions for the support of education";
-the shifting of existing State General Fund expense obligations to the Education Fund; and
-the reduction of any existing State General Fund revenue support to the Education Fund?

Art. 25. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

Art. 26. To adjourn this meeting.
