The Cabot Board of Selectpersons did meet as warned on 18 October 2006 at 7:00 p.m.

Attending were: Andy Leinoff, Patricia Brochu-Cox, Stephen Cox, Juliann Ambroz, Harry Thompson, Ron Lay-Sleeper, William Walters, Jessica Miller, Ted Domey, Larry Gochey and Caleb Pitkin; Chair; Selectboard, Christopher Kaldor; Town Clerk - Treasurer.

Selectboard [SB] Agenda, copy attached hereto, reviewed and duly noted.

Caleb called the meeting to order at 7:50 p.m. following the Public Hearing for the proposed UDAG Plan Revision.

1. Andy asked the SB to reconsider transferring the existing UDAG funds [currently in AG Edwards, Morgan Stanley and Banknorth NA] to the Union Bank immediately, prior to the vote on the UDAG Plan Revision; discussion ensued. Larry noted he's not in favor of moving any funds [from their current accounts] prior to the November 7 vote; further discussion ensued. No action taken.

2. Agenda Item - AI 1 – Larry moved to approve the minutes of 4 October 2006, as printed; Ted seconded. No discussion, motion passed unanimously.
