a. ambulance impacts and needs,

Dean briefly discussed the availability of FEMA grants to help staff first responders and assist in paying for payroll grant period runs for three years, 75% match first two years 35% third year, This pays for full time or part time positions or volunteer positions.

Skip and Dean indicated what the needs of an Ambulance service would be from a spatial need. Ambulance and or fast squad service would require the following:

- Bay area for vehicle,
- accessible storage min 12x12 for medical supplies
- secure office and file storage area,
- access to the training area and
- hazmat cleanup hazmat bay should fit ambulance unit
